**Motion:** Gary Grefer, Second Grady Fuller. Ties for regular season Division Championships will be broken based on head-to-head competition results. If a tie still remains, the teams tied will be declared co-champions.

## Motion passed, 8-2.

**Motion:** Gary Grefer, Second Grady Fuller. In the Gulf Coast Division, all base runners may advance at their own risk on an errant throw to first base a maximum of one base.

## **Umpire Status**

Gary Grefer reported on efforts to recruit additional umpire candidates. One consideration was the amount we paid umpires, per game, as compared to what was being paid in Naples.

**Motion:** Gary Grefer, Second Grady Fuller. Increase the umpire fee to \$30 for 7 inning games and \$35 for 9 inning games. **Motion Passed: Unanimous.** 

The Board then discussed the need to evaluate the performance of umpires, as we do the performance of managers. The Board agreed to create an accountability program for umpires, asking managers to evaluate the performance of umpires on specific criteria. The results will be shared with each umpire, and will serve as a basis for making decisions on continuing to use an umpire in the league in the future years.
